January 2011 – BC Hydro Geotechnical Studies

BC Hydro is conducting geotechnical studies along the Peace River, in the area of the proposed dam, as part of Stage 3 of the Site C Clean Energy Project.

On **January 27**, members of the Site C engineering team will be conducting a helicopter flight above areas adjacent to the Peace River. The purpose of the flight is to assess conditions of existing forestry roads and seismic lines at specific areas along the south bank of the Peace River, between Fort St. John and Hudson's Hope. This assessment is being done as part of 2011 geotechnical field work planning.
