Dear neighbour,

We're writing with an update on the fish habitat enhancement project underway near your community.

In May 2022, work began on the fish habitat enhancement project on P6 island to add permanently wetted habitat within the Peace River. All access works to the island are complete as well as clearing activities.

We're on schedule to complete in-river excavation by the end of October.

Through the late summer, hauling operations were reduced which led to some decreases in noise and dust. As a result, hauling from P6 island will continue into early 2023. As we approach shorter daylight hours, lighting is needed for worker safety. Light shrouding on P6 island will be used and lights will be directed away from Old Fort to the best of our ability.

Reclamation on P6 island, including spreading topsoil and woody debris, will be done after hauling is complete in early 2023. Works further upstream around P5 island will occur in 2023.

We have heard your concerns about construction and are continuing efforts to mitigate those impacts. We'll continue to provide you with updates on our works near your community.
