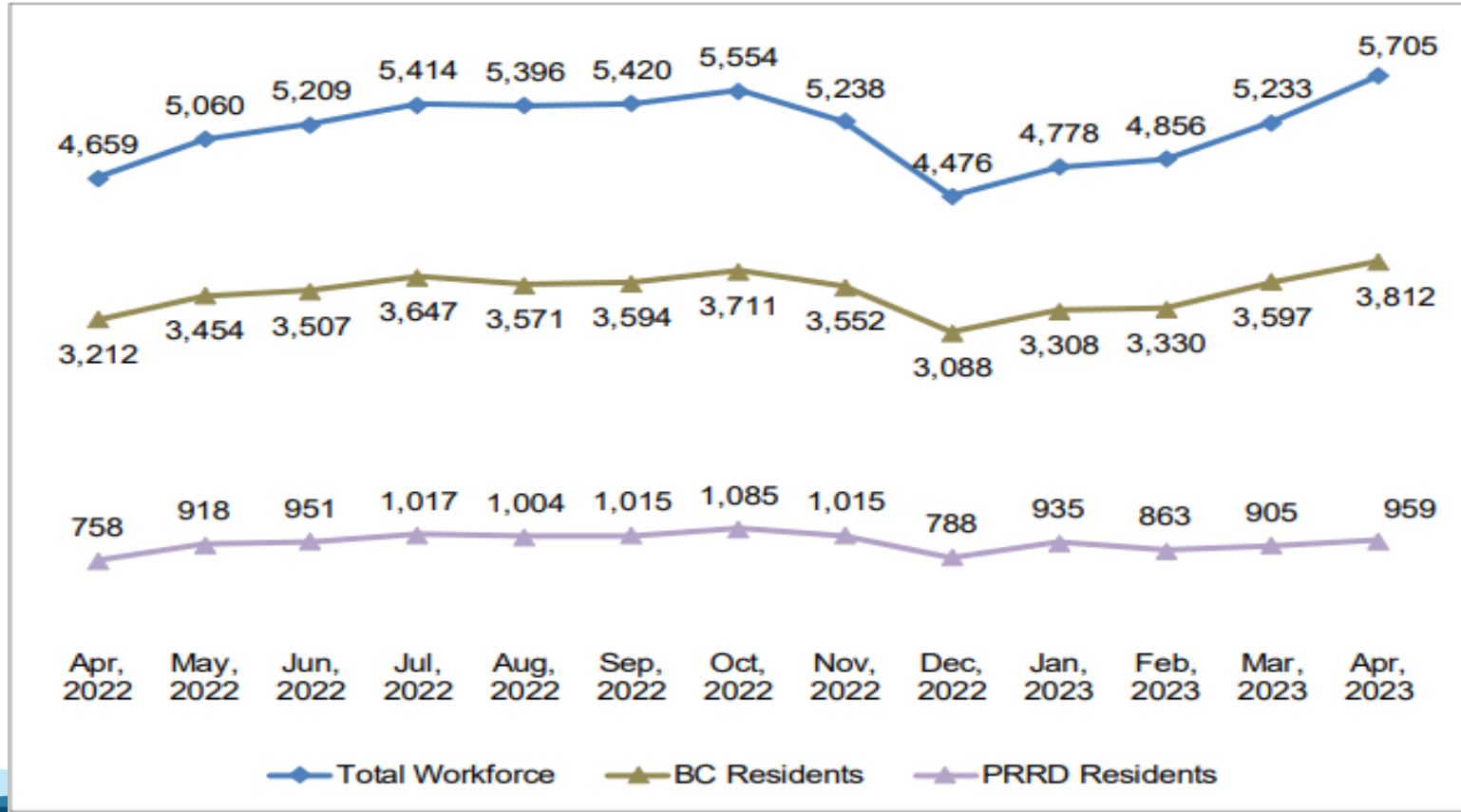

- Total of **5,705** workers in **April 2023**: **3,812** from BC (67%), **959** from PRRD (20%)
