Synopsis:

Sunday: warm air again crosses the Rockies as moderate to strong SW surface winds push the arctic air northwards again. Venting will be good.

Monday: Arctic air slides south again in the early evening. However venting will remain good through the afternoon hours with strong southwest winds persisting. Watch for the venting to quickly drop late in the afternoon as the winds swing out of the north.

Tuesday: Arctic air remains in place with light upslope winds. Venting poor.

Comments: Arctic air looks to remain in place through Thursday with poor venting associated Tuesday to Thursday. Both US and Canadian long range model guidance support warming for Friday but respite will be brief.
