Synopsis:

Thursday: arctic air retreats north through the day as the next pacific system floods the Peace corridor with warmer air ushered in by strong SW winds. Winds will peak in the late evening. Venting good in the afternoon

Friday: a westerly flow aloft sets up maintaining moderate to strong winds, warmer air and good venting for the burn site.

Saturday: pressure gradient eases over the Peace corridor with light upslope winds developing. Venting deteriorates to poor as cooler air settles southward.
