Construction notice: 85th Avenue Industrial Lands and conveyor belt corridor

Dear neighbour,

Starting this week, construction activities will begin on the installation of a five-kilometre-long conveyor belt system that will be used to transport materials from the 85th Avenue Industrial Lands to the Site C construction site.

The conveyor belt system will run adjacent to Shaman Industrial Way, and cross under Old Fort Road and 240 Road through culverts.

This work consists of excavation and pile driving (to install the brackets/supports for the conveyor) and will take approximately three months. In addition, road work associated with the culvert installations will take approximately two months to complete.

The conveyor belt is expected to come into service during the summer of 2019, and will be used to transport materials to the dam site until 2023.

What to expect

During conveyor belt construction, you may notice:

- Increased truck traffic along the conveyor belt corridor.
- Day, night and weekend shifts with pile-driving activities generally occurring between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
- Increased noise levels near the 85th Avenue Industrial Lands and the conveyor belt corridor. We will monitor noise levels in accordance with our [Noise and Vibration Management Plan](#) which can be found on the project website: sitecproject.com.
- Occasional single-lane, alternating traffic along Old Fort Road and 240 Road during installation of the culvert. Traffic control personnel will manage traffic during this time.
