Dear Eugene Lim:

Under Section 52 of the *Forest and Range Practice Act of British Columbia*, I am authorizing you to remove vegetation from the crown land (indicated on the attached map) for the purpose of supporting the fish habitat enhancement work.

This authorization is valid for two years, from **November 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022, to November 24<sup>th</sup>, 2024**. The following conditions apply to this authorization:



- Avoid cutting down any merchantable timber during the operation
- Avoid disturbing wildlife habitats if found during the operation
- Restrict the clearing operation within the area indicated in the map
- Follow the waste disposition standard described in the request letter
- Avoid any operation that might have an adverse impact on the surrounding environment
- Approval is only to remove vegetation from the crown land to support fish habitat enhancement work
- Compile with rules and regulations set out by Forest Act and Forest Range and Practice Act that are relevant
